WALNUT VILLAGE BOARD MINUTES Tuesday, January 21, 2025

The meeting with the President and Board of Trustees held on the 21st day of January 2025 started at 7:00 p.m. in the Village Hall in the Village of Walnut, IL.

President Rosenthal stated that he spoke with our attorney, and he said we do not have to put this contract out for bid because it is considered a public utility and not a project. President Rosenthal and Dye are going to meet with Pozzi on Friday, January 24, 2025, at 3:00 p.m.

<u>Law & Order</u> – Stull stated that the committee just had a meeting to discuss the future needs for the Police Department. They are going to run a couple ads for a Chief and part time police officers. Stull would like to see 10-15 hours a week and increase the hourly wage to try and to get some people interested in the job. They also discussed body cameras and a new computer.

<u>Local Improvements</u> – Smith handed out the project summary for the solar at the sewer plant. The solar project at the sewer plant is now running. The only thing left to do is the fencing and they are providing the fence because of insurance and liability.
