

WALNUT VILLAGE BOARD MINUTES
Tuesday, April 1, 2025

The meeting with the President and Board of Trustees held on the 1st day of April 2025 started at 7:00 p.m. in the Village Hall in the Village of Walnut, IL.

President Rosenthal directed the Clerk to call roll, and the following Trustees answered present:, Brian Stull, John Middleton, Lee Johnston, Brian Smith and Melissa Dye. Bryan Arteberry was absent.

President Rosenthal asked if there were any additions or corrections to make to the regular meeting minutes from March 18, 2025. With no corrections made, a motion made by Smith and second by Johnston to approve the minutes. On roll call vote, all present voted in favor and the motion carried.

Treasurer Wolf presented the bills for \$22,906.39. A motion was made by Stull and second by Dye to approve the bills as presented. On roll call vote, all present voted in favor and the motion carried.

Superintendent Minks received an email from CMS who is our rock salt supplier. They are asking the Village Board to give Spt. Minks permission to purchase salt. A motion made by Middleton and second by Johnston to approve the rock salt submission. On roll call vote, all present voted in favor and the motion carried.

Treasurer Wolf asked the Board again about switching the Village Office and Police Dept. Office over to Conxxus. A motion made by Stull and second by Smith to approve switching the Village Office and Police Dept. Office over to Conxxus. On roll call vote, all present voted in favor and the motion carried.

Finance Committee – Scheduled a meeting for Wednesday, April 9 at 6:00pm.

Streets & Alleys – Johnston stated that he had a meeting on March 31st to discuss budget items.

Water & Sewer – Scheduled a committee meeting with the Finance Committee for Wednesday, April 9 at 6:00 pm. The water project on Main Street will start on Monday, April 14th it should be completed that same week.

Garbage – President Rosenthal received the contract from AM Disposal and has sent that over to the attorney for review. President Rosenthal wanted a few things added to the contract. He wanted the various dumpsters provided for the Village including the roll off dumpsters for the Fourth of July Celebration. He also added the Main Street decorative trash cans need to be dumped weekly.

Law & Order – Nothing at this time.

Cemetery – Cemetery clean up is April 7th through April 11th. People will be able to put stuff back out on graves on Saturday, April 12th.

Local Improvements – Nothing at this time.
