

**WALNUT VILLAGE BOARD MINUTES**  
**Tuesday, July 22, 2025**

The meeting with the President and Board of Trustees held on the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of July 2025 started at 7:00 p.m. in the Village Hall in the Village of Walnut, IL.
