

**WALNUT VILLAGE BOARD MINUTES**  
**Tuesday, September 16, 2025**

The meeting with the President and Board of Trustees held on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of September 2025 started at 7:00 p.m. in the Village Hall in the Village of Walnut, IL.

At this time President Rosenthal swore in Dean Hulsing as the new Trustee.

A motion made by Stull and second by Miller to approve the new Village Committee members for FY 2025-2026. On roll call vote, all present voted in favor and the motion carried.

President Rosenthal stated that he spoke with Chief Roush. Chief Roush has been working on some abandoned vehicles in town. He has sent 10 letters out over the past few weeks. So far 7 of the 10 letters have been resolved.

The Police Chief position is still posted on Indeed. We have received six resumes. Hopefully within the next month we will have some interviews.

Streets & Alleys – Spt. Minks received an update from Helm today. The outlets and the contactor so the lights come on with the photocell should be installed this week.
